Aphelel repented and has been restored. The question of what happens after death was the focus of the study on Saturday. On Sunday Robin spoke on forgiveness. We left directly after the Sunday morning worship so we could meet with the Uitenhage church in the afternoon.

We were delighted to meet baby Haya, daughter of Michael and Imayema. She was born on Saturday morning at about 8AM. This is their third child.

Our trip to Namibia has been postponed until **September** as requested by the brethren there. Also, Robin is scheduled to go to Harare, Zimbabwe in August for a gospel meeting. |(Robin and I plan to travel to Namibia together).

We have enjoyed good reports of the work in Uitenhage, King Williams Town, Seymour and Bhisho.
