
Stewardship of the Gospel

- *If* you miss a day don't quit.




Parable of the Sower

- Fruit production is the purpose of sowing seed.







What are Thorns?

- The thorns are "worries, riches and pleasures of life." (Lk. 8:14)
- The thorns are the cares and concerns of this life.
- The thorns are the desires and concerns that drive us to fill our lives with things that don't directly impact the kingdom of God.

- The thorns steal our focus from God and his kingdom.
- The thorns steal our affection from God.
- The thorns steal our energy from the real work God has called us to do.
- Worry Riches Pleasure.
- Worry Stuff Fun.

Good Soil

- Antioch
- Acts 11:19 26
- "The Disciples Were First Called Christians at Antioch" (11:26)

• Fruitful Leaders

- In Acts 11, Barnabas and Saul were the main teachers in Antioch.
- In Acts 13, more than a year later, there were at least 5 prominent prophets and teachers in Antioch; among whom were Barnabas and Saul. (Ac. 13:1)
- In Acts 15, a few years later, there were many others in Antioch teaching and preaching the word of the Lord. (Ac. 15:35)


Antioch: Teaching At Home and Far Away

- In Acts 13 and Acts 15, the disciples at Antioch were willing and able to send Barnabas and Saul away to sow the seed in other parts of the world.
- Luke records, "when they fasted and prayed and laid their hands on them, they sent them away" (13:3)





Paul's journeys




Good Soil in Galatia

- As Paul and Barnabas travelled throughout the cities of Galatia, Jews grew more hostile to the message and followed them from city to city, instigating persecution. (14:19)
- Their encouragement, "Through many tribulations we must enter the kingdom of God." (14:22)



Good Soil in Galatia

- The Fruit: "They Appointed Elders For Them In Every Church" (14:22)
- More Fruit: "Having Prayed With Fasting, They Commended Them To The Lord In Whom They Had Believed" (14:22)



Good Soil in Ephesus

- The Fruit: "All Who Lived in Asia Heard The Word of the Lord." (19:10)
- Disciples carried that message with them.
 - Disciples confessed Christ as Lord.
 - Followers proclaimed the gospel.
 - Disciples told others what the Lord had done for them and how he had mercy on them.
