"THIS IS HOW ONE SHOULD REGARD US, AS SERVANTS OF CHRIST AND STEWARDS OF THE MYSTERIES OF GOD. MOREOVER, IT IS REQUIRED OF STEWARDS THAT THEY BE FOUND FAITHFUL." (1 COR. 4:1 – 2)

Stewardship

- The conducting, supervising, or managing of something; *especially*: the careful and responsible management of something entrusted to one's care *<stewardship of natural resources>*
- Union Steward, Principal, Coach, Parent.

Steward

- Luke 12:42 "Who then is the faithful and sensible <u>steward</u>, whom his master will <u>put in charge</u> of his servants,"
 - "steward" (Gk. *oikonomos*) a *house distributor* (that is, *manager*), or *overseer*, that is, an employee in that capacity; by extension a fiscal *agent (treasurer);* figuratively a *preacher* (of the Gospel): chamberlain, governor, steward.

Talent

Matthew 25:14 - 18



An Enormous Stewardship

- Talent
 - represented a huge sum of money, (gold or silver)
 - 26 31 Kilos per one talent
 - 1 kilo of gold approximately \$42 K




Gift Users

 - "after a long time"
- Luke 12:48 b "From everyone who has been give much, much will be required; and to whom they entrusted much, of him they will ask all the more."

Gift Users

• (1 Peter 4:9 – 10).

Gift Abusers

- Matthew 25:24 25 Excuse
- "Master, I knew you to be a <u>hard man</u>, reaping where you did not sow and gathering where you scattered no *seed*. And I was afraid, and went away and hid your talent in the ground. See, you have what is yours."

Gift Abusers

- Master's response: Matt. 25:26
- "You wicked, lazy slave, you knew that I reap where I did not sow and gather where I scattered no *seed*. 27 Then you ought to have put my money in the bank, and on my arrival I would have received <u>my *money*</u> back with interest. "

• (Matthew 25:29 - 30) "For to everyone who has, *more* shall be given, and he will have an abundan but from the one who does not have, even what h does have shall be <u>taken away</u>. Matt. 25:30 "Thro out the worthless slave into the outer darkness; i that place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth."
