LUKE 12

Jesus talked about Money

- Sixteen of the thirty-eight parables were concerned with how to handle money and possessions.
- ▶ In the Gospels, an amazing one out of ten verses (288 in all) deal directly with the subject of money.
- ► The Bible offers 500 verses on prayer, less than 500 verses on faith, but more than 2,000 verses on money and possessions.

Fiduciary

- ► Ex. 19:5 "Now then, if you will indeed obey My voice and keep My covenant, then you shall be My own possession among all the peoples, for all the earth is Mine;
- ► Job 41:11 ""Who has given to Me that I should repay him? Whatever is under the whole heaven is Mine."
- "A fiduciary duty is the highest standard of care. The person who has a fiduciary duty is called the fiduciary, and the person to whom he owes the duty, is typically referred to as the principal or the beneficiary."

The Rich Farmer

LUKE 12

Luke 12:13 - 15

- "Someone in the crowd said to him, "Teacher, tell my brother to divide the inheritance with me."
- ▶ 12:14 Jesus replied, "Man, who appointed me a judge or an arbiter between you?"
- ▶ 12:15 Then he said to them, "Watch out! Be on your guard against all kinds of greed; life does not consist in an abundance of possessions."

Blunders of the Rich Farmer

Assumed he was the owner

▶ (Psalm 50:12) "For the world is Mine, and all it contains."

Failed to give thanks

- ► Acts 14:17 "He did good by giving you rains from heaven and fruitful seasons, satisfying your hearts with food and gladness."
- ▶ "But those who want to get rich fall into temptation and a snare and many foolish and harmful desires which plunge men into ruin and destruction.
- ► "For the love of money is a root of all sorts of evil, and some by longing for it have wandered away from the faith and pierced themselves with many griefs. (1 Timothy 6:9 – 10)

Blunders of the Rich Farmer

- Wrong thinking regarding what to do with blessings.
 - Was not rich toward God
- ▶ Thought his barns contained all he needed.
 - "Thou hast made us for thyself, O Lord, and our heart is restless until it finds its rest in thee." <u>Augustine of Hippo</u>, <u>Confessions</u>

Blunders of the Rich Farmer

- Finally, our "successful" farmer forgot about **time and death**.
 - ▶ (Eccl. 2:18 19) "Thus I hated all the fruit of my labor for which I had labored under the sun, for I must leave it to the man who will come after me. And who knows whether he will be a wise man or a fool? Yet he will have control over all the fruit of my labor for which I have labored by acting wisely under the sun. This too is vanity."

Blunders of the Rich Farmer

- Finally, our "successful" farmer forgot about **time and death.**
 - "The evidence of our mortality and life's uncertainty is not just compelling, it is overwhelming." (Earnhart)
 - The only thing that will survive death is a secure relationship with God.

What will God say to me?

- Will God say of you or me, "You fool! This very night your soul is required of you, and now who will own what you have prepared?" (Luke 12:20)
- "What will it profit a man if he gains the whole world and loses his own soul?" (Mark 8:36)
